cleaning. I had a rather easy
day. This evening we went

for it is Allie's birthday, we
had a very nice supper and
the dining room was all
decorated very pretty. They sure
did a lot of work. John's was
there also. After we ate, we
looked at some pictures on the
slide, there was a few pictures
of Ray's wedding, - and also
Ray Landino's wedding, and
also pictures of Olivia and
her three brothers, and they
sure came out swell. We
should have a few picture made
again. We put the boys to bed
and then we came home. Larry
listened to the ball game on the
radio. Bobby went out, and I
went to bed. A full day. Thank God.
